

Dear IGC,

First off, we would like to thank you for presenting to the F@CU committee. Upon reviewing your presentation, the councils have agreed to award IGC with the request \$21,000 for the 2007-2008 academic year.

This allocation of \$21,000.00 to IGC for the 2007-2008 academic year is meant to ease the proposed transition of the IGC campus recruiting drive from the fall semester to the spring. This figure matches the requested amount in the initial budget submitted to F@CU, but while the committee is pleased to have been able to provide the amount requested, it should be stressed that this is a one-time \$3,000 increase to assist in a fundamental program change. Future increases will be considered when timely and appropriate as needed.

The Councils felt that IGC was taking steps to become a larger presence on Columbia's campus, as exemplified by the work that is being done with multicultural fraternities and sororities. We are excited about the contributions you have made to the Columbia community in the past, and look forward to the additions and changes you are looking to make in the upcoming year.
