

Dear Jordan and WKCR,

We would like to thank you for presenting to the FaCU Committee. We were all excited to hear about WKCR's important place in Columbia's tradition. As was already communicated to you earlier this year, the FaCU committee has allocated \$27,730.19 to WKCR for the 2007-2008 academic year.

Your presentation provided us with important information about WKCR's importance to undergraduate student life, as well as to the promotion of alternative programming not only at Columbia, but in New York at large. We recognize the need for WKCR to build a permanent fund that will ease fundraising pressures in the long run. Based upon the application that was submitted and presented to us, the allocation awarded to WKCR for this upcoming academic year represents a total amount for summer housing for WKCR staff, travel and car rental expenses for coverage of away games of Columbia sports teams, and replacement of studio equipment and supplies.

We are currently working with Columbia Housing to secure free or discounted summer accommodations for WKCR staff; in the event this becomes available, the total allocation to WKCR from the student councils will be reduced by the value of the free or discounted portion of this summer housing.

We hope you understand that the allocation was agreed upon with the monetary needs of the five governing boards and the limited resources of FaCU in mind. The members of FaCU once again would like to thank you for your dedication to preserving such a unique tradition at Columbia.
